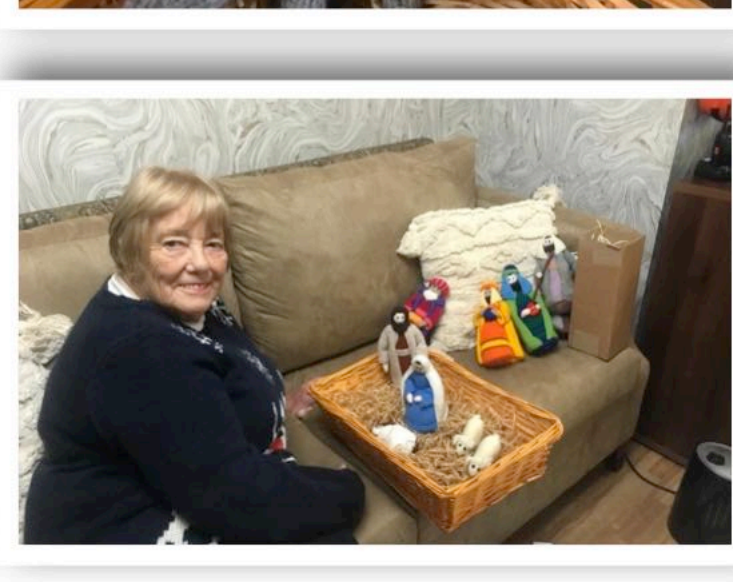

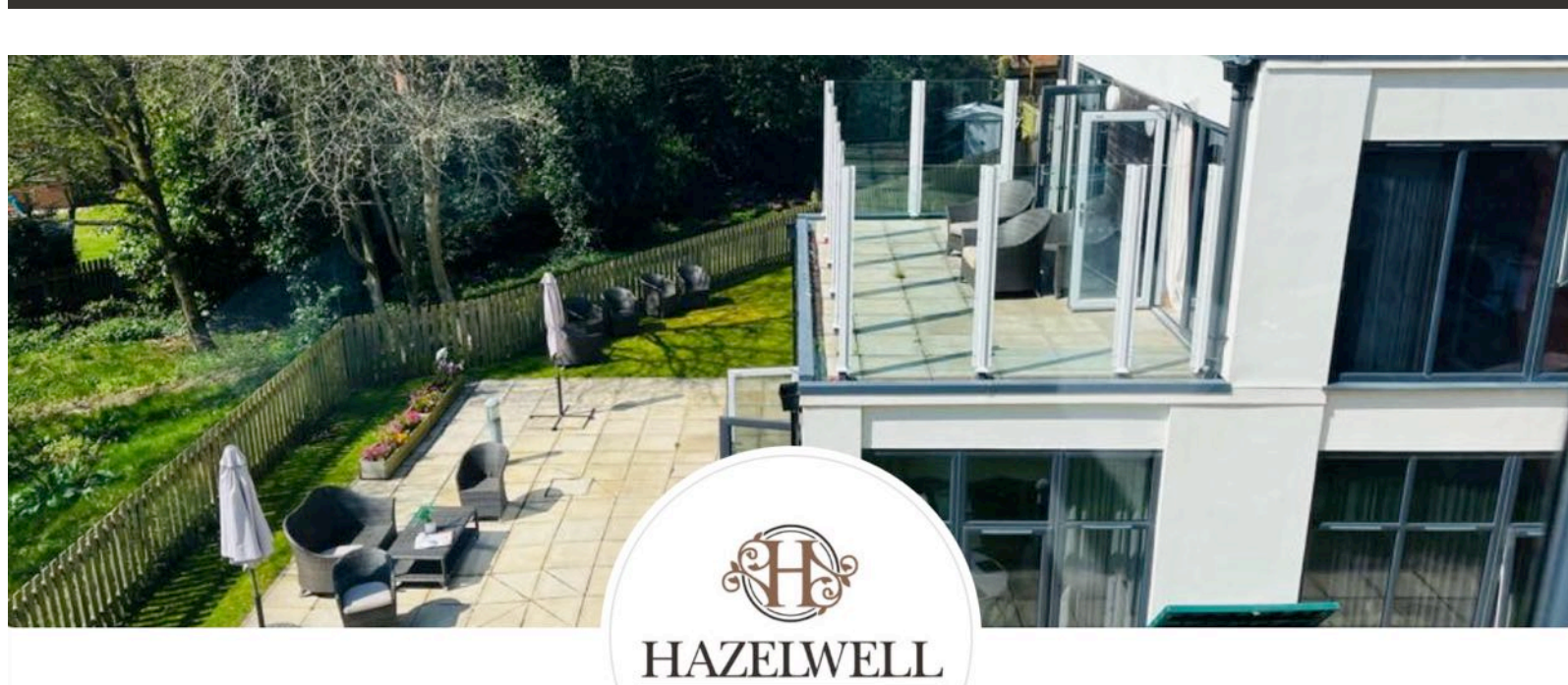
## 'Tis the Season...

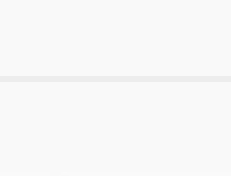
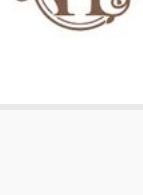
