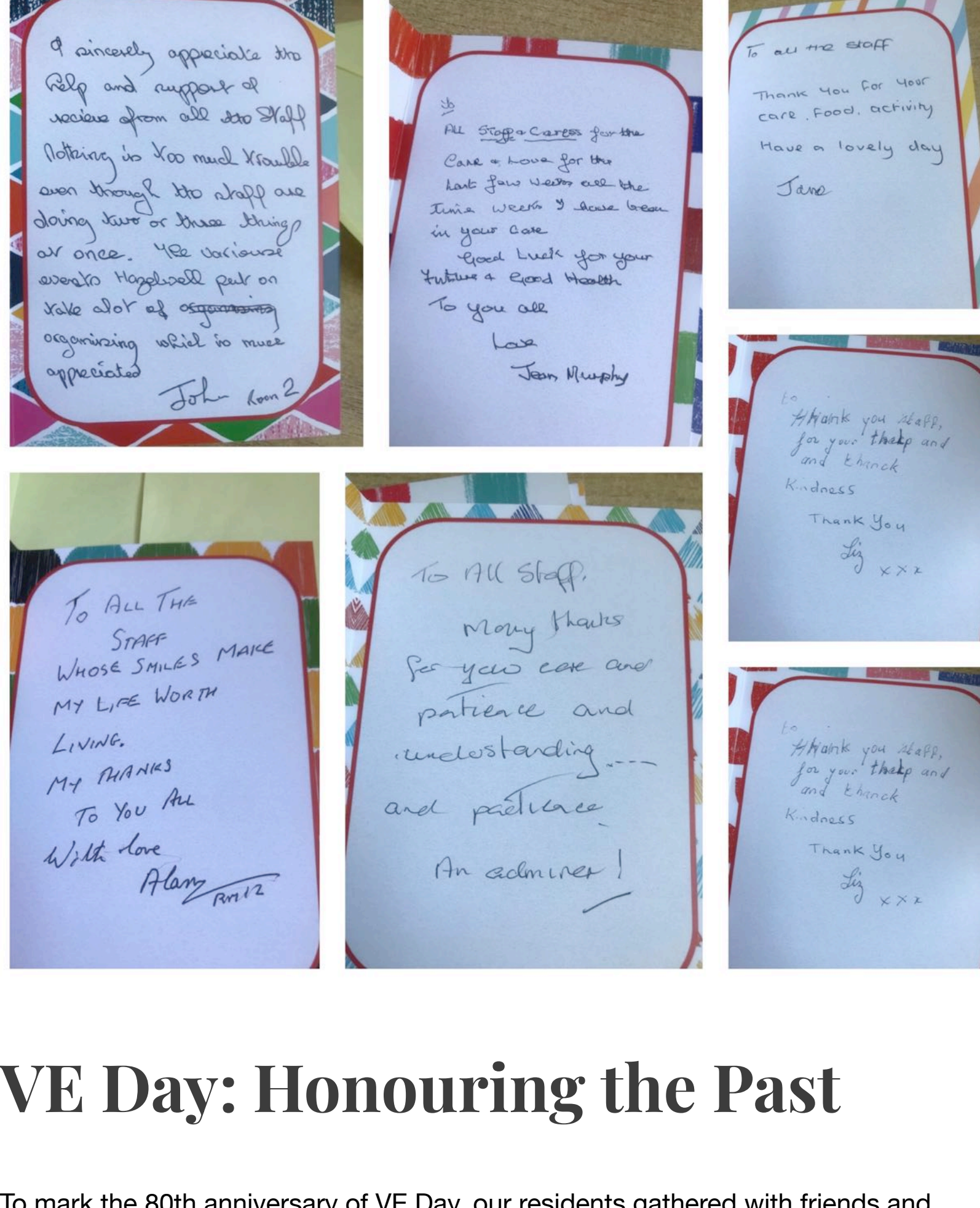
Heartfelt Thanks from Our Residents

We're proud to report that following a recent assessment by Wirral Borough Council, our accommodation services have been rated as 'Good'.

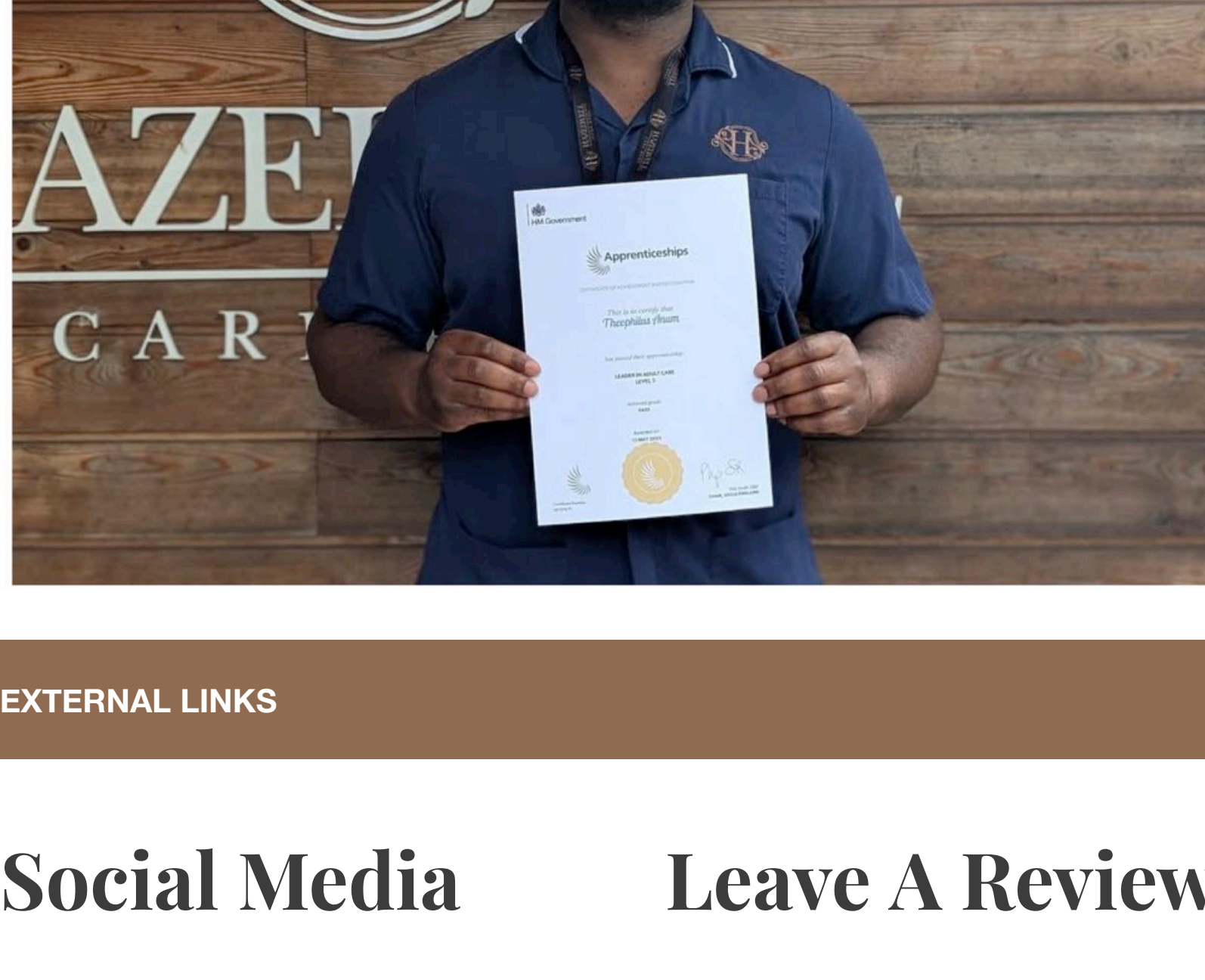

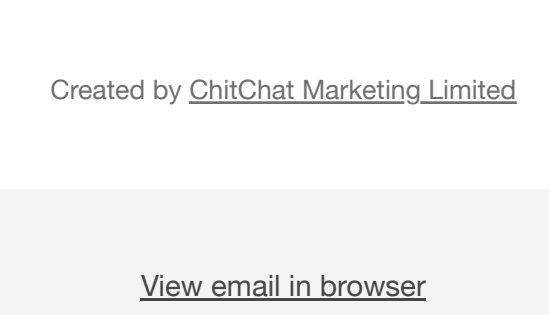
